

Course setter info

Kainuu MTBO Week, Finnish MTBO Cup, 2.-7.7.2023, Kuhmo

Sun 2.7. Kalevalan sprort center, sprint 10:00

Mon 3.7. Multikangas shooting range, middle distance 11:00

Wed 5.7. Huhtikangas shooting range, long distance 11:00

Fri 7.7. Kuhmon sport center, longer middle distance as chasing start 13:00

Kainuu MTBO Week will be ridden in Kuhmo in different type of terrains. Each of four racing days have its own character and offers variety of challenges both from courses and terrains point of view.

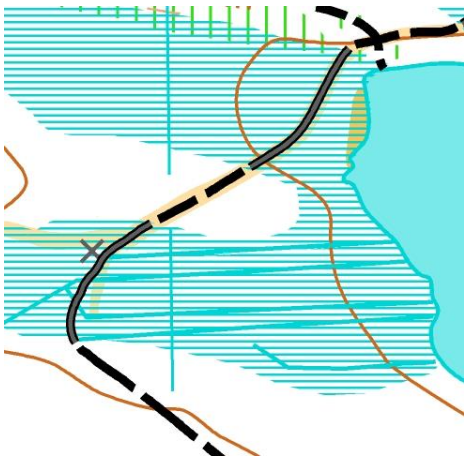
First race is ridden in Kalevalakylä few kilometers from Kuhmo city center. Kalevalakylä terrain is fast pine forest terrain with asphalt surface summer-ski track. There also exist old camping area with caravan slots and small field roads. Area has moderate high differences with some dense slopes. Area is rather small and there is lot of controls. Be careful with control codes and order of the controls. Most of the courses have A4 size turn-map (except H21 class with three maps and H/D11 classes with one map). To be clear control and code numbers are a bit smaller from the standard.

Second race is ridden in Multikangas area. Paths are again fast but high differences somewhat bigger. Area is again rather small and there are crossings with courses. All the courses go through the same small a bit more technical path. To be clear control and code numbers are a bit smaller from the standard.

Third race goes to Huhtikangas-Tipasoja terrains known from 2013 WOC long distance race. Now the are isn't small – there exists tens of kilometers of nice paths and small roads. Courses are truly long so make sure you have enough liquids and energy with you. There are no drink controls during the courses. Longer courses have forkings so be careful with control order. Maps are weather proof (except in shortest courses with A4 map).

Last race is ridden in Mäntymäki-Keskusta terrain with chasing start (not younger than 13-year old and classes with less than five participants). Terrain has three different characters – pine forests area, not-so-dense swamp-forest area and urban city area. Map scale is changed during the longer courses.
