COMPETITION RULES

The competition will be held according to the rules of the Finnish Orienteering Federation and the rules given by the organizer.

ENTRY AND REGISTRATION TO COMPETITION CATEGORIES

All entries for competition categories must be made by May 31st, 2026, at 24:00:

Late entry and registration (with higher participation fee) must be made by June 7th, 2026, at 24:00 directly through the IRMA service or via MTBO Week's [webshop](#).

Participation fees are determined based on the payment date as follows:

ENTRY AND REGISTRATION TO OPEN COURSES (Open / recreational orienteering)**1. PRE-REGISTRATION TO KAINUU MTBO WEEK'S OPEN COURSES**

Pre-registration with discounted participation fees is possible by using the [webshop](#) until 20th of June 2026. Pre-registration with discounted participation fees is possible only for the whole week participation (4 competition days). Pre-registration participation fees:

By 30th November 2025:

After arriving to the Competition Centre go to the MTBO Week's info and you'll get ticket for the open course MTBO. Open courses are conducted independently without timing.

CANCELLATION AND CHANGES NOTICE!

Before registering, read the terms of the cancellation and changes from website: <http://www.rastiviikko.fi/en> → 2026 → Cancellations and changes. When a participant has registered for an event either through the IRMA service or web-shop, it is considered that the participant has accepted these terms of cancellation and changes of the event.

Changes of the SIAC number

- Changes to the registered SIAC number are free of charge until 7th of June. Participants can change the SIAC number directly in the IRMA service (until 7th of June) or by e-mail info@pikhafit.fi.
- In competition classes from 8th of June onwards the change of the SIAC number is possible ONLY by email into info@pikhafit.fi and an office fee 5€ will be charged.

Transfer or cancellation of the event

- If the event has to be transferred (into the new organizing dates) due to bad conditions or emergency (Force Majeure) all already paid participations will be automatically transferred into the new organizing dates of the event.
- If the event has to be transferred (into the new organizing dates) due to bad conditions or emergency (Force Majeure) and if the participant then cancels the registration, the whole participation fee will be paid back. In this case we will charge an office fee of 5 € / participation day / participant.
- If the event has to be cancelled due to bad conditions or emergency (Force Majeure) and if the participant then cancels the registration, the whole participation fee will be paid back. In this case we will charge an office fee of 5 € / participation day / participant.

PUNCHING SYSTEM

The SPORTident Air+ punching system will be used in every category of the Kainuu MTBO Week (KMTBOW). If you have your own SIAC, the number of the card must be given as you register. Organizers will reserve rental SIACs for those who do not have their own card. The rental of the SIAC is 5€ per day or 15€ per week. The rented SIACs can be picked up from the KMTBOW info at the Competition Centre. The rent must be paid on-site if it is not already paid. If the participant doesn't return the SIAC, we will charge 100€.

COMPETITION CENTERS

First and second day competition center is [Hyrnsalmi comprehensive school](#) (navigation address: Kaarnatie 1, 89400 Hyrnsalmi).

Third day competition centre is [Haverinen skiing center](#) (navigation address: Haverisentie 7, 89600 Suomussalmi).

Fourth day competition centre is [Suomussalmi open-air theater](#) (navigation address: Lomakyläntie 25, 89600 Suomussalmi).

Competition centers have info and WC premises and also restaurant/café services.

It is forbidden to camp in the area of the competition centers and the competition terrains! You can use normally areas' hotel and cabin accommodation and Kainuu Orienteering Week's race village services.

TERRAINS

The Hyrnsalmi-Istonspitkä sprint terrain is an urban settlement crossed by outdoor trails and small forested areas.. The Ajarata-Multimäki, Haverinen and Lomakylä-Hietasärkät terrains feature variable elevations with numerous trails through pine forest ridge and depression terrains.

Terrains are off-limits for training until competitions of the orienteering week in these areas have concluded.

- 29.6. Hyrnsalmi comprehensive school, middle distance
- 1.7. Haverinen skiing center, long distance
- 3.7 Suomussalmi open-air theater, middle distance

More precise course distances for each class will be published closer to the event week.
